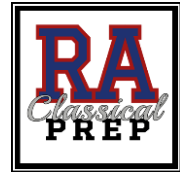

OVERVIEW

Royalmont Academy Classical Preparatory offers a robust academic curriculum delivered via a classical approach to education within the context of Catholic formation. The culture of our school promotes maturation for future leaders in a sincere, joyful, and virtuous environment free from many distractions and is directed toward students' discovery of their gifts and purpose.

A private high school of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, Royalmont Academy Classical Preparatory is accredited by the Ohio Catholic School Accrediting Association (OCSAA). The school is located twenty-five miles north of Cincinnati, surrounded by suburban and rural communities in one of the fastest growing areas of southwest Ohio.

Our 110,000 square foot building rests on 14 acres and is home to Royalmont Academy Classical Preparatory High School and Royalmont Academy Preschool and Elementary. The campus houses 59 classrooms, a chapel, two libraries, two gymnasiums, a state-of-the-art weight room, an auditorium, two computer labs, a chemistry lab, an expansive art studio, an interior courtyard garden, and ample outdoor space.

PHILOSOPHY & MOTTO

Royalmont Academy employs a philosophy of Integral Formation built upon the Christian view of the whole person. The four pillars in which each student is formed are intellectual, spiritual, human and apostolic. Our Latin motto "Semper Altius" means "Always Higher". It expresses our desire for our students to achieve the maximum integral development possible across the four pillars of formation.

ENROLLMENT

Royalmont Academy was founded in 1996. The Royalmont Academy Classical Preparatory for grades 9-12 was added in 2014 and graduated its first class in May of 2015. The high school currently enrolls 39 students.

FACULTY AND RATIOS

Our high school faculty includes 2 Doctoral degrees, 4 Masters degrees, and includes 3 clergy/religious. Student Teacher Ratio is 5:1 (classroom teachers only).

ACTIVITIES & ATHLETICS

As a member of Ohio Christian School Athletic Association (OCSAA) and the Ohio Valley Christian Conference (OVCC), the Royalmont Cristeros sport teams include basketball, volleyball, cheerleading, cross country, and track and field. A number of students also participate in local club teams for football, swimming, rowing, and ultimate frisbee.

A variety of student activities are available, including an annual theatre production, competitive Certamen (Classics) team, ProLife Club, SPEAK for Others, RA Book Club and Catholic small faith groups.

In addition to traditional classroom instruction, Royalmont Academy Classical Preparatory also partners with Benedictine College, Mount St. Joseph University, Sinclair Community College, Miami University Regionals and various online curriculum providers for College Credit Plus, Dual Credit, Advanced Placement, and blended learning opportunities for our students.

Colleges our former graduates are attending: University of Cincinnati, University of Kansas, Benedictine College, Marian University, Ave Maria University, Miami University, Xavier University, and the University of Dayton.

CLASS OF 2018

Our current senior class boasts one National Merit Scholarship Semi-Finalist, with two students who scored a 35 on the ACT. The class ACT average is 25. Our senior class has had a classical liberal arts education which has included Logic and Rhetoric, Latin and Spanish, Classical Literature and History, Theology, Composition, Persuasive Speech and Debate.

Our graduates attracted more than \$1,635,000 in scholarship offers. 100% of the graduates of the Class of 2017 attend degree granting institutions.
